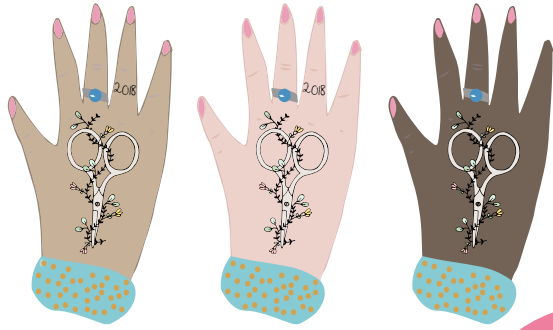
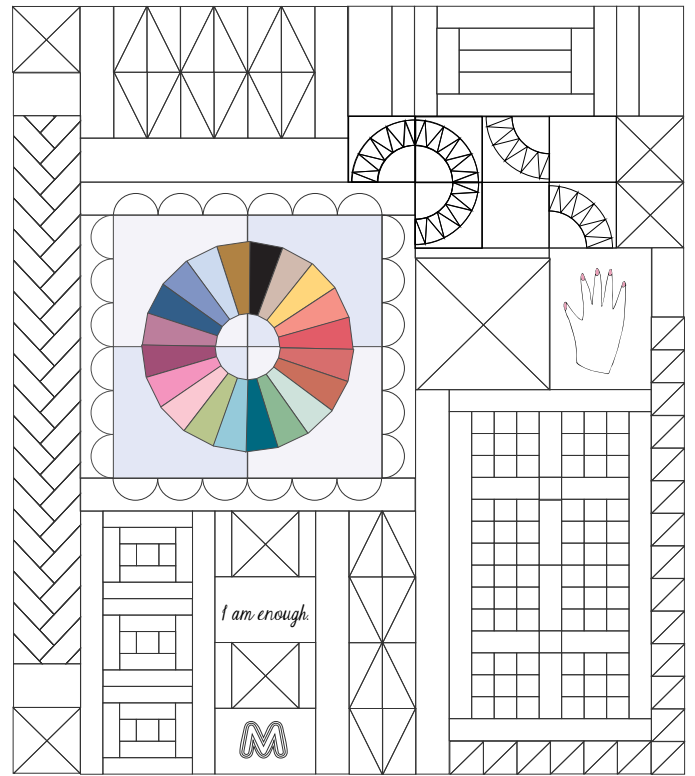

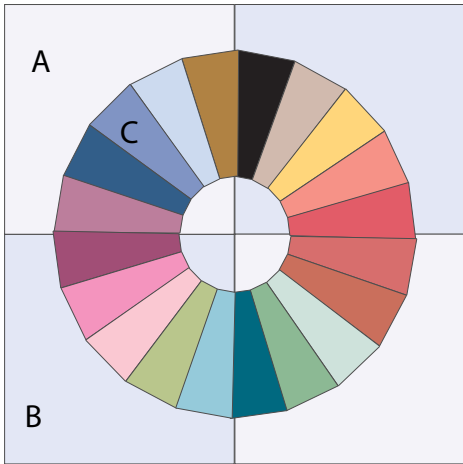

## Pattern 1 YOUR Color Wheel



- Measures 24.5".

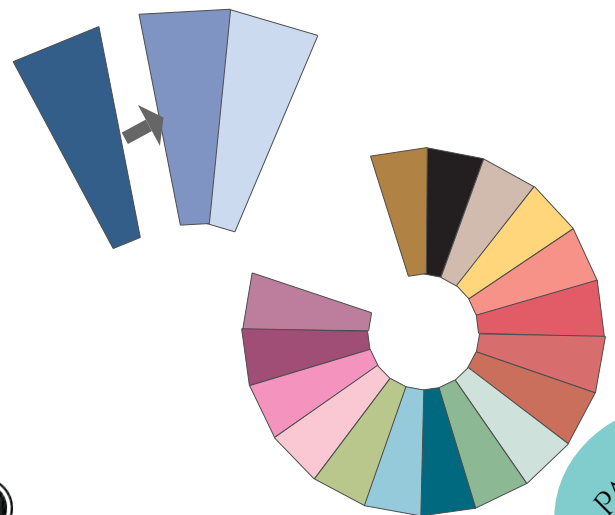
You will need:

- Fabric A - (2) 12.5" squares
- Fabric B - (2) 12.5" squares
- Fabric C - (20) 3x 6.5" blades
- Optional dresden ruler or template
- Charlottes Fusible Web

### Wheel

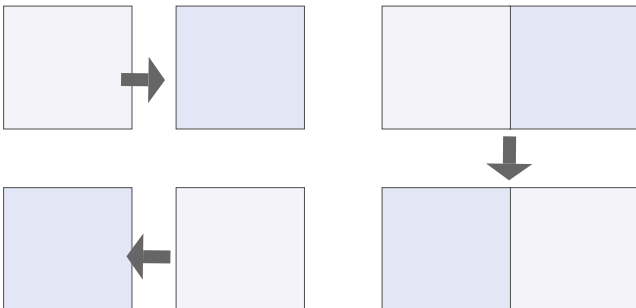
1. Sew each of your Dresden blades together. Continue until they form a circle. Press all seams to one direction.
2. Sometimes the inner circle is tricky to line up. If your inner circle is uneven, trim up until evened.
3. Using the fusible web thread in your bobbin, sew closely to edge around the outer circle and the inner circle (if you have a favorite applique method different from the one I'm using, feel free to use it).
4. Place wheel in center of background blocks. Press to set the fusible thread. Gently remove top thread.

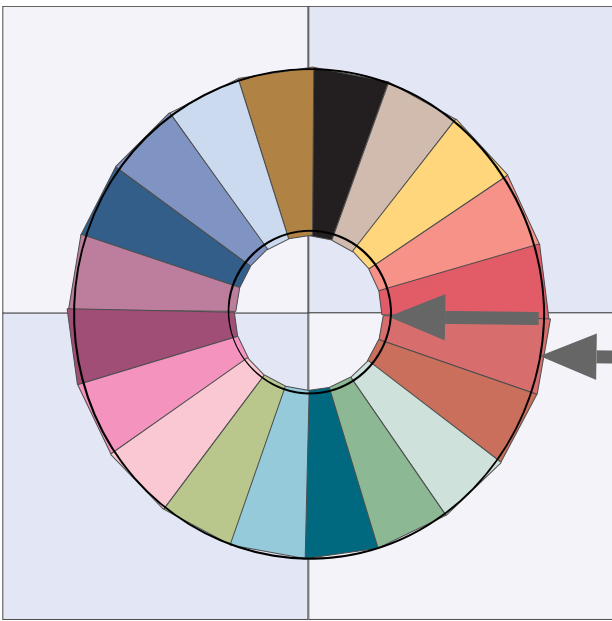


Read all instructions before beginning. Sew right sides together and use a 1/4" seam allowance unless otherwise instructed.

### Background

1. Sew a square A to a square B. Sew a square B to a square A. Press seams in alternating directions.
2. Sew both rows together. Press seam open.
